What is Corpus Hacks?

Corpus Hacks is a 12-hour student-run hackathon for female and nonbinary high school and college students in the Bay Area. We hope to provide participants with an inclusive environment where they can engage in workshops, learn from industry experts, find peers with similar interests in computer science, and develop their coding skills in a stress-free setting. In addition, they will also receive free swag, prizes, and food.

Why should you help us?

Corpus Hacks is a non-profit organization and we depend on sponsorships and donations to be able to run our event. Sponsoring our hackathon will help close the gender gap in computer science and provide aspiring students from diverse backgrounds with an environment to build and develop their computer science knowledge. Your company will also be able to advertise to an audience of talented student hackers.

What perks will you get?

Distributing swag • You can distribute company swag to participants, such as stickers, office supplies, etc.

Speech • A representative of your company can give up to a 5-minute speech at the opening and/or closing ceremony.

Company banners • Company banners will be put up on display outside and/or inside the venue. The donation amount and corresponding perks can be negotiated.

How can you help?

Donate money • All of the money donated will be used to fund the venue, prizes, swag, meals, etc. This is the best way to help us, but all forms of sponsorship are appreciated. Since we are non-profit, all donations are tax-deductible!

Sponsor a meal • Help us by providing breakfast, lunch, dinner, or snacks for our participants.

Provide a venue • Provide a location (ideal for holding up to 100 participants) in the Bay Area to hold the hackathon.

Provide tools for attendees • Offering accessibility to software such as APIs for all hackers will give our participants more flexibility with their projects.

Mentors and judges • We need industry experts to help guide the participants during the hackathon and judge their projects.
